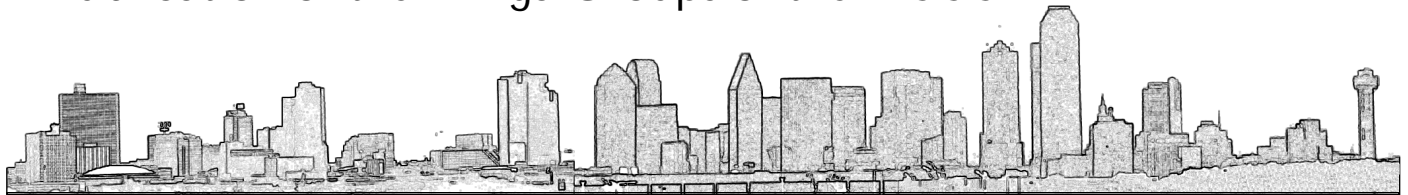

Flea Market Extravaganza

Since the MCCC has held an annual show for the past twelve years, it was decided that our club would have the Flea Market Extravaganza and invite other Texas Amiga user groups to attend the show. Directions & Parking

The Brookside Convention Center is located at 1244 Brookside Drive in Hurst. To get to the Convention Center get to Highway 183/121 and take the Precinct Line Road exit and drive south on Precinct Line Road. After approximately 0.3 miles turn left (east), on Bedford Euless Road. Drive 0.4 miles to Brookside Drive. The Convention Center is on the southeast corner.

Classes

This year we hope to be having classes, but we need your help. Your input is necessary to determine whether or not we will have any classes or demonstrations at the show. Please contact our Educational Chair, David Owens, or myself and let us know what type of classes you would attend. Also, if there are any volunteers out there that would like to teach a class, let us know.

Flea Market

The flea market will be run the same as last year's. The flea market will be open to members for a fee of 5% on items sold. A fee of 10% will be charged to non-members on items sold. Spread the word to all your non-member Amiga friends, or former Amiga users. Flea market forms should be available at the July chapter meetings. Items will be collected during chapter meetings beginning in August. If you can not attend a meeting, contact a designated collector. A list of collectors will be presented in the August newsletter.

Other Attractions

Local dealers will be invited to attend the show. Since this is a Texas show we will invite other Texas dealers to attend. We will be having door prize drawings throughout the day. You need to be present to win. We are working on obtaining a guest speaker for the event. The entire software library for the Amiga will be available to members. The annual special on memberships will be offered: thirteen months for the price of twelve. (This offer is good even if your membership is unexpired). We also hope to have a few computers set up so you can ask the club's resident gurus for help and advice.

Mark your calendar for Saturday, October 10, and dust off your unused hardware and software. Spread the word, save up your money and prepare for a good time. The count down for The MCCC Flea Market Extravaganza '98 has begun!
